- Mark reported his team worked over 140 hours over the holidays without complaints.


2.0 **Old Business**


- 2.1 Alderman DeLong moved to approve Ordinance 22-17 on second reading, an ordinance to amend the Greenbrier Zoning Ordinance and Official Zoning Map of the City of Greenbrier, Tennessee, by rezoning one parcel from R15 to R8 Zoning District. Alderman Deaver seconded the motion and passed with a 7-0 roll vote.
- 2.2 Alderman Davis moved to approve Ordinance 22-18 on second reading, an ordinance to amend the Greenbrier Zoning Ordinance and Official Zoning Map of the City of Greenbrier, Tennessee, by rezoning one parcel from A Agricultural to CC General Commercial Zoning District. Alderman Deaver seconded the motion and passed with a 7-0 roll vote.
- 2.3 Alderman Davis moved to approve Resolution 23-01. A resolution to declare certain items to be surplus and directing the disposal of same. Alderman DeLong seconded the motion and passed with a 7-0
